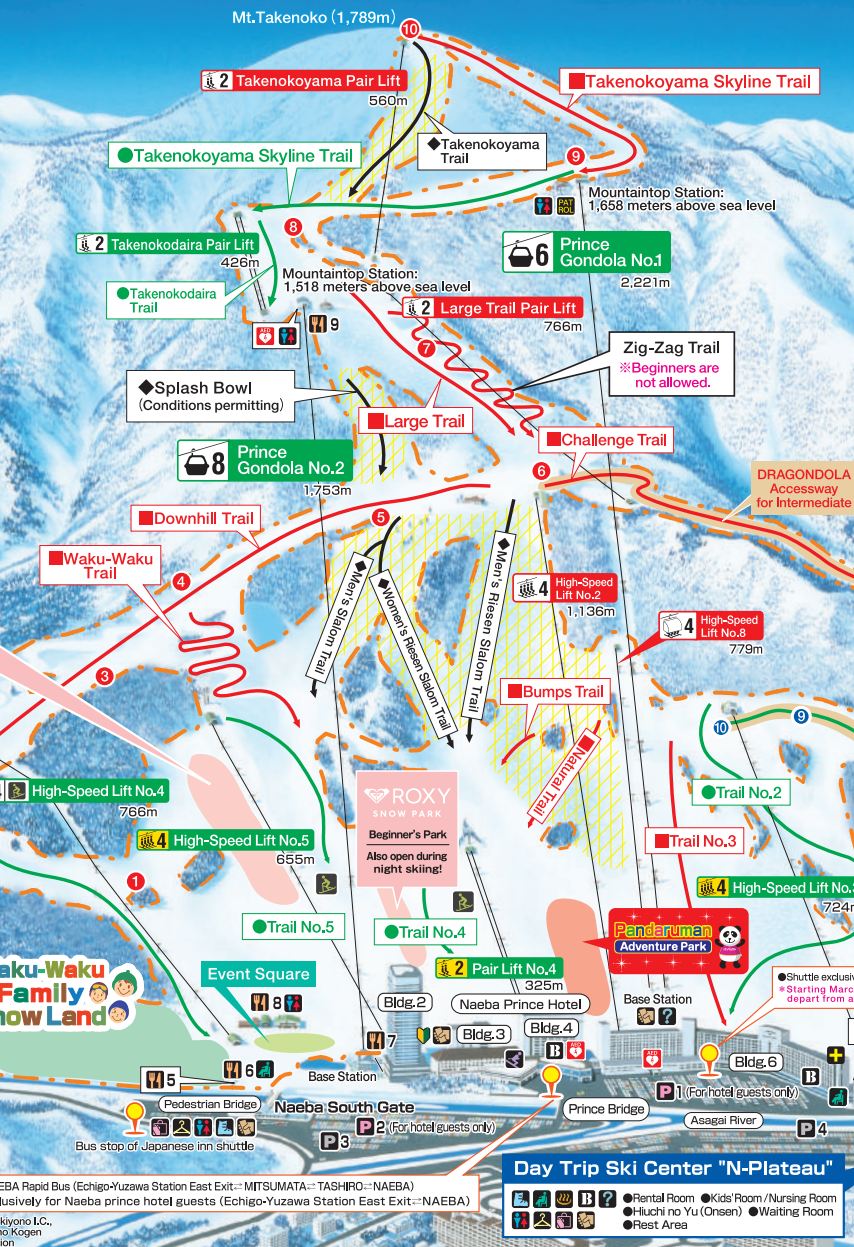

- Information on signboards installed in the ski Resort
- NO LIFT NO PATROL: No lifts or patrol are beyond this point.
 - SKI AREA BOUNDARY DO NOT CROSS: Demark ski resort boundaries.
 - ON HOLD DO NOT PASS THE SIGN: Trail under inspection
 - AVALANCHE DANGER: Danger of snow-slide
 - SLOW: Glide slowly in the slow zone.
 - 合流注意: Junction Beware of others
 - No: Number signboard to specify trail landmarks or emergency rendezvous locations
 - No: Number-board for moving to the Dragondola boarding area.

Skiing and snowboarding are outdoor sports. We ask that visitors adhere to the Ski Area Users' Agreement and Guidelines put up on our website and trails to avoid accidents.

1. Do not hurt or endanger other skiers.
2. Follow the Ski Area rules to prevent accidents.
3. In case of an accident, the situation will be handled in accordance to the Ski Area Users' Agreement and Guidelines.

Requests for NAEBA Ski Resort visitors who venture outside (backcountry) the Trail Supervising Area Boundary:

- Leave the boundaries at the designated spots to avoid mishaps.
- Remove your skis when going outside the boundaries to avoid leaving ski-trails which may cause a mishap.
- Make sure to submit a designated mountain climbing registration form each time to your nearest patrolman station. (We'll be in charge of keeping them for the police.)
- When going into the backcountry, please make sure you are fully equipped with the proper gear.
- Skiers will take responsibility for their activities when outside the boundaries.
- It is recommended that skiers carry a device for determining latitude/longitude in the event of an emergency.
- A communication device should be kept on hand in the event of an emergency.
- Please refer to NAEBA Ski Resort on Facebook for the latest weather report and snow conditions.
- Emergency search and rescue charges will be fully paid at your own expense.
- In the event of an emergency, please inform your name, contact address and number, color of your ski gear, the location where you went outside the boundary, your present physical condition (mishap, injury, snow-slide) and your latitude/longitude. The police will be informed of the situation and we will act in accordance to their instructions.
